

Why in Hamburg?

Hamburg organizes deportation charter flights for the European Union, since 2004 at least 8 times to African countries.

◦ Since January 2008, the Hamburg Foreigners Office has established two new "staff functions for controlling and international cooperation", serving, for example, for organizing such charter flights. This is done in cooperation with, among others, the airline company "Hamburg International"

FRONTEX, the European Border Agency, participates in such mass deportations since some time, as well as in "identifying" refugees for issuing traveling certificates. Only in 2008, FRONTEX is going to participate in organizing 8-10 deportation charter flights coordinated on an EU-level, some of which will for sure take place again in Hamburg.

FRONTEX also carries out training programs for its staff at Federal Police Academy in Lübbeck near Hamburg.

The Camp

The Antiracist Summer Camp 08 takes place in the context and in the continuity of multiple antiracist struggles against German and European border regime, of previous No Border Camps, of No Lager Tours and of our resistance against the G8 in Heiligendamm.

The focus shall be the big airport-occupation-demo. We're going to flood Hamburg Airport. No matter how, by which means, by whom...

...no matter if overdressed style with smoking suit, tourist style with trolley, loud style with soundsystem, autherical style with flight ticket, demo style with banners, angry radical style with sunglasses, colorful clowns style or syply as you like it...

TO FLOOD means to be creative, means to block the airport in one way or another as long as we can... means to soak the airport with liters of fantasy of resistance means to FLOOD

We also go to the FRONTEX training center at Lübbeck; we make them feel our anger, we expose them in public, we show a sign against the border regime.

... **We pull them into limelight!**

We're going to disturb the bureaucrats during their work at Hamburg Foreigners Office and at the Central Reception Center; we draw the out of anonymity.

... **We bring out their faces!**

Our loud presence shall get to big and small ears of the "open-minded metropolis" of Hamburg; we shall become an issue of public concern.

... **We bring ourselves loudly into the city!**

Besides this, there shall be space for workshops, discussions, exchange of experiences, networking, chatting, planning, subculture...

A space for us, with us, organized by ourselves in a freedom-loving, non-oppressive context... besides this a base for offensive actions as we like it.

... **WE are me, you>all<we, you, them, and all our friends**

Exclusion and control against refugees and migrants

Along the external borders of the EU, the European Border Agency FRONTEX coordinates more and more restricted militarised practices of violently excluding people. Only in 2006, at least 6000 people died in the sea around the Canary Islands holiday paradise (2 million of tourists a year). FRONTEX also participates in mass deportations and in "identifying" refugees for issuing traveling certificates.

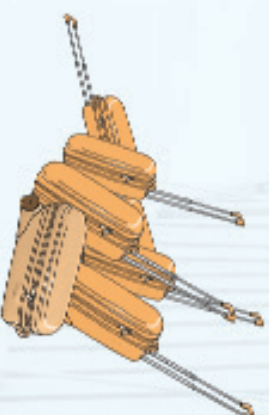
At the German-Danish border, taxi drivers were arrested because they didn't control the passports of their passengers. The fortification practices in the Atlantic, in the Mediterranean Sea and along the eastward border are part of the externalisation of border controls, reaching from restricted visa rules to interception camps in the Ukraine and in Northern Africa.

The control-mania at the borders goes along with permanently advancing surveillance and data control on the internal level: Central registration of patients and of pupils, for example, means a massive limitation of undocumented people's possibilities to remain undiscovered. But also refugees and migrants who have papers are again and again brutally confronted with their exclusion by special laws and by racist controls and attacks. With the status of "Duldung", discriminated people are deprived of their Freedom of Movement also internally by the racist "residential restriction law (Residenzpflicht)" because they are being denied the freedom to decide where they want to live.

At the end of this chain, there is deportation, carried out in a more and more perfect, invisible and commercial way. As deportations with scheduled flights (for example with the Lufthansa deportation company) could again and again be stopped or publically exposed by resistance, practical solidarity or publicity, smaller companies are now specializing for deportation business. This shall make resistance of deportees, their communities and solitary people more and more difficult and, first of all, deportation shall be drawn further and further away from critical public attention.

What would be if...

- ... the right of education was worth more than deportation threats; if kids could go to school without being afraid of denunciation and stigmatization?
- ... there was medical care for everyone, not asking for papers, if the hippocratic oath counted more than the immigration law?
- ... there were equal labour rights for all and everyone could chose freely if and what she or he wants to work?
- ... the legalisation of immigrants and their families was achieved as a result of the struggle?
- ... liberation from surveillance was our answer to repression and security-mania?
- ... global Freedom of Movement replaced borders?
- ... Solidarity replaced racist prejudice and people could talk the language, follow the belief and live the culture they chose, wherever and whenever they like?
- ... if people could love the sex and the gender they like?
- ... if there was selfdetermination instead of integration?



This is what would be!

- ... A world that never forgets the past, that breaks the present and goes into another future with a laughter.
 - ... Another world where all of us live together in solidarity, without exclusion and exploitation, without racism and sexism, without nations, without domination, without discrimination, a world without structures in which physical and psychological death is permanently present and the status quo keeps crushing souls and bodies.
- We are fighting smaller and bigger struggles, we are fighting on different levels:**
- ... First of all, we want everyone to have access to all rights. United!
 - ... Equal rights for all!

But we also expose these very rights to be insufficient and to be attempts to calm us down.

All must be changed!
