

Imprisoned for the right for free movement?

Cornelius Yufanyi, activist of the refugee organization "The Voice Refugee Forum Germany", had been sentenced in September 2003 to pay a fine of 323,20 Euro for violating the 'Residenzpflicht'-law. Cornelius Yufanyi then had announced that he would not accept the judgement and that he would not pay any amount of money for violating the discriminating law that contradicts international law. Now he is threatened by being imprisoned. On Thursday, 27th October 2005 he is supposed to appear at court. Cornelius Yufanyi will not follow this request to extradite himself to the authorities voluntarily, expressing thereby his fight against the racist law.

We appeal to all persons who receive this letter to send faxes to the authorities in charge to protest against the authorities' proceedings in the case of Yufanyi as well as against the racist law. For this you can use the letter proposal attached below or you can write one on your own.

As the warrant of arrest against Cornelius Yufanyi will be going out already on Thursday, 27th October, protest should be expressed as soon as possible. The addresses of the authorities in charge are:

Faxnachricht

Betrifft: Cornelius Yufanyi, Aktenzeichen 403 Js 51861/00 4.4, Haftaktenzeichen 72 M 867/05

Hereby we demand the withdrawal of the warrant of arrest against Cornelius Yufanyi.

Cornelius Yufanyi has claimed his rights for freedom of speech and political engagement and his right for free movement. We will not accept that a person has to pay the penalty of simply claiming its human rights.

We would like to criticise the proceedings of the 'Ausländerbehörde' and the judgement of the German Courts that still support the 'Residenzpflicht' law.

We demand with Cornelius Yufanyi the abolishment of the 'Residenzpflicht' law and furthermore demand the unlimited right for free movement for all asylum seeker.
