

## **Outcome of Migration Network Assembly**

The Migration Network in ESF, in conclusion of the 5th ESF in Malmo, has agreed to keep working against the EU border regime and for migrants rights.

We call migrants movements, social movements and trade unions to join the struggle:

- Against the border regime as it produces death, repression and illegality and as it is the main instrument of discrimination and precarization of migrants. That is why we oppose FRONTEX, the Dublin II Regulation, the EU "return" Directive, the readmission clause, the externalization of the EU border regime.
- Against the criminalization and the exploitation of migrant labor and for migrants social rights.
- For a permanent and unconditional legalization of all migrant men and women and the unconditional right to stay for all children born or grown in Europe.
- On these axes we will continue to promote the process of transnationalization of our struggles. The next steps will be the "Citizens summit" in Paris on October 17-18 and a common call addressed to all social movements for a period of European-wide actions and mobilization on December 10-18.
