Exchange with activists from countries of origin and transit of refugees in Africa
about the EU migration policies

in the "Rote Flora" (Convergence Center Hamburg, CCH)

For the migration-related actions against the g8 summit, we invited activists from different African countries (DR Congo, Ivory Coast, Senegal, Mauritania, Morocco, Tunisia), who are fighting there and on a transnational level against the EU migration policies.

They will take part in the big demonstration (2.6.), the transnational networking meeting (3.6.), the action day on migration (4.6.) and the alternative summit in Rostock. Because most of them arrive in Hamburg, we want to organize a public workshop for an exchange among each others:

- Activists from Hamburg and refugees present the situation and activities of different groups against the policies concerning refugees and migration here.
- The activists from Africa report on the situation, debates and struggles in countries of origin and transit.

In the discussion we should ask for common demands (e.g. for global freedom of movement and equal rights for all) and coordinated activities also beyond the g8 summit (e.g. against EU charter deportations, camps and border controls).

The workshop will be held in German and French, if necessary also in English.
